Oleksandra Matviichuk is a Ukrainian human rights activist and director of the Centre for Civil Liberties. Together with her organisation, in 2022, she was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize, Right Livelihood Award and the European Parliament's Sakharov Prize for Freedom of Thought.

Artūrs Kučs is a Latvian human rights expert and, since 2024, a judge of the European Court of Human Rights. He is an alumnus of the EMA Programme from 2002 and was National Director for Latvia of the EMA Programme for almost two decades.
